- Genesis 25:30** **Esau** (to Jacob): Please let me have some of that red stew you have there. I'm famished! (That's why he was nicknamed **Edom**, which means "red.")

- Genesis 32:3-4** Jacob *knew he* had to pass by the territory of **Edom** where his brother Esau lived in the land of Seir. He sent messengers ahead with a message for Esau. **Jacob** (to his messengers): This is what I want you to say to my master Esau: "Your servant Jacob says this: 'I have lived with Laban as a foreigner and stayed *there working for him* until now.'

- Genesis 36:19** These were the tribes and tribal chiefs descended from Esau (who is *also known as Edom*.)

- Genesis 36:20-21** The sons of Seir the Horite, who also inhabited the land, were Lotan, Shobal, Zibeon, Anah, Dishon, Ezer, and Dishan. They became the tribal chiefs of the Horites (who were the sons of Seir) in the land of **Edom**.

- Genesis 36:31** There were kings who reigned in the land of **Edom** *long* before any king ruled over the Israelites:

- Genesis 36:32** Bela (Beor's son) ruled in **Edom** from his city Dinhabah.

- Genesis 36:43** Magdiel, and Iram. These were the *tribal* chiefs of **Edom** (who is *also known as* Esau, the father of **Edomites**) according to the land they owned and where they settled.

- Genesis 37:1** Jacob ended up settling in the land where his father had lived as a foreigner *for many years*—in the land of Canaan.

- Exodus 15:15** *Even* now the chiefs of **Edom** are deeply disturbed; Moab's leaders cannot stop trembling; all who live in Canaan are *deeply distressed and* wasting away.

- Numbers 20:18** **Edom's Message**: No. If you so much as put a foot in our territory, we'll attack you.

- Numbers 20:20** **Edom's Message**: Absolutely not. *At that point*, the **Edomites** indeed came out in force, fully armed, against the Israelites.

- Numbers 20:21** This response proved there was no negotiating with **Edom** for passage, so the Israelites turned to go another direction.

- Numbers 20:22-23** The whole Israelite community packed up and left Kadesh. They journeyed to the edge of **Edomite** territory, to Mount Hor, *specifically*.

- Numbers 21:4** And the Israelites set out again. They left Mount Hor and traveled by way of the Red Sea, skirting **Edom**; but *again*, the *difficult* travel gave everyone a short temper.

- Numbers 21:23** Sihon would not allow them to pass. Instead, he roused all the Amorites and attacked the Israelites right there in the wilderness. They battled it out at Jahaz.

- Numbers 24:18** **Edom** will be its possession, even Seir will belong to its enemies, but Israel will have power.

How can I let you settle *here on this side of the Jordan*, while your kinsmen *on the other side of the Jordan* may have to go to war in order to possess the land? Why would you dishearten the rest of the people *today* just as the spies did who disheartened the people in the last generation after I sent them from Kadesh-barnea and they saw the Eshcol Valley and the surrounding land?

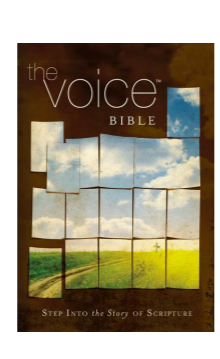

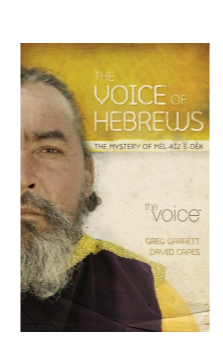
